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## CORRIEDALE WOOL FLEECE

All Corriedale sheep are covered to keep the wool clean, the pens are also covered. This double covering produces an impressive, clean, fleece. The sheep are not exposed to sun or rain.

## Corriedale Fleece 2C9

2C9 is an unbread yearling ewe, the staple length is 5 inches, the weight of fleece with minor skirting is 10.4 lbs. The fleece has been covered. Prior to delivery the fleece will be thoroughly skirted. The final weight will be used in pricing at \$20/lb.

**4C9 is an unbread yearling ewe, the staple length is 4 inches, the weight of fleece with minor skirting is 9.4 lbs. The fleece has been covered. Prior to delivery the fleece will be thoroughly skirted. The final weight will be used in pricing at \$20/lb.**
